



REQUIREMENTS FOR TEMPORARY VISITOR'S VISA

1. One (1) copy of FA Form 2-A (application form);
2. Passport valid for at least six (6) months beyond the intended period of stay in the Philippines;
3. Certificate of Employment or proof of financial capability;
4. Police Clearance (with official English translation);
5. Photocopy of airline ticket (return ticket not later than thirty (30) days from date of arrival in the Philippines);
6. Travel insurance for COVID-19 treatment costs from reputable insurance providers, with a minimum coverage of USD 35,000.00 for the duration of their stay in the Philippines.
7. Hotel Booking reservation;
8. Two (2) photographs taken in the last six (6) months;
9. Fully vaccinated (except for minor children below twelve (12) years traveling with their fully-vaccinated foreign parent/s);
10. Other documents that may be required by the Consular Officer;
FOR ENTRANCE YOU NEED TO PROVIDE:
 - a) Acceptable proof of vaccination,
 - Received the second (2nd) dose in a 2 – dose series or a single dose vaccine more than fourteen (14) days prior to the date and time of departure from the country of origin/port of embarkation;
 - The vaccine is included in any of the following: Emergency Use Authorization (EUA) List or Compassionate Special Permit (CSP) issued by the Philippine Food and Drug Administration, or Emergency Use Listing of the World Health Organization;
 - b) Acceptable proofs of vaccination: World Health Organization International Certificate of Vaccination and Prophylaxis, **or** VaxCertPH, **or** National or state digital certificate of the country/foreign government which has accepted VaxCerPH under reciprocal arrangement, **or** other proofs of vaccination permitted by the IATF; (To date, there is no mutual recognition of vaccine certificate between the Philippines and Serbia)
 - c) Negative RT-PCR test taken within forty-eight (48) hours or a negative laboratory – based Antigen Test taken within twenty – four (24) hours, prior to the date and time of departure from the country of origin/first port of embarkation in a continuous travel to Philippines;
 - d) After receiving test results, it is mandatory to complete registration with the Bureau of Quarantine following this link: <https://onehealthpass.com.ph/e-HDC/OHP-Registration/>

Foreign spouses

11. Proof of marriage (marriage certificate issued by the Philippine Statistics Authority, or apostilled/authenticated in case of documents issued by a foreign government);
12. Report of Marriage, if married abroad and the applicant has no PSA copy yet;
13. Proof of Filipino citizenship of spouse (copy of PH passport);
14. Copy of passport and residence permit;
15. Copies of entry and exit stamps from the Philippine's Bureau of Immigration;
16. Visa fee of US\$ 40 – 5 days;
17. For expedite processing additional US\$ 10 – 2 days.
